Spring Maintenance Tips

1. Remove leftover salt

A good wash and wax will help prevent rust and corrosion. Salt, used on roads to melt ice and snow, can cause serious damage to cars, especially their undercarriages.

2. Replace wiper blades

Winter weather can be quite harsh on wiper blades. Spring and fall are ideal times to change.

3. Change oil and check fluids

If your last oil change was before winter, then this is a great time to do it. Don't forget to also check your brake and cooling system fluids.

4. Rotate tires and check air pressure

Keep your tires at recommended pressure range, typically 30-32 psi. Check your tire for specifics. Mechanics recommend tire rotation every 5,000 miles.
